Purpose

The purpose of course analysis is to focus on personal development in the field of teaching. To achieve this in a high-quality manner, cooperative forms are used. The aim is to evolve from coexistence to cooperation.

Description of the Activity

After using the identified subject / topic / problem in the course of the action plan, students focus on their personal development.

The lecturer can guide the reflection process by using questions (e.g. the following ones):

- What was my personal goal?
- What were my focal points to achieve it?
- How did it work out?

After this personal reflection the teacher-students share their thoughts and conclusions with the S-PLC group. All members of the group are asked to bring in their thoughts and ideas.

The aim is to evolve cooperation as a useful tool to gain experience in reflecting as well as giving feedback to others in a constructive, cooperative way.

Additional Information



Alternative

It is also possible to get through the first step of the reflection process not only by oneself, but also by setting up small groups of 2-3 persons focusing on the same subject / topic / problem. Then some additional time must be planned for the procedure.
